#### **Attendance Policy for Preschool**

Regular attendance plays an important role in your child's social, emotional and cognitive development. When children consistently attend school, they build strong relationships with peers and adults while also engaging and participating in enriching and meaningful experiences. Chronic absences may hinder your child's success and academic performance in later years. For this reason it is imperative to develop regular attendance habits early on in preschool years.

If your child accumulates 10 consecutive unexcused absences at any given point during the school year, he/she will be removed from the program and your child's place will be offered to a child on the waiting list.



#### Important for reporting absences!

Please notify the classroom teacher, our Main Office or the school nurse (medical updates) when your child will be absent from school. Please note how absences are defined below:

#### **Excused Absences**

- Observance of a religious holiday recognized by the New Jersey Department of Education
- Take Our Children to Work Day
- Participation in observance of Veteran's Day

#### **Unexcused Absences**

Absences for reasons other than the above are considered "unexcused."

All other absences, which are not State recognized Excused Absences according to the above, shall be considered "Unexcused Absences" regardless of the reason or documentation.



#### **Breakfast & Lunch**

- Children will eat in the classrooms.
- Hackensack Public School menus.
- Please fill out a Lunch Form. It can be found on our <u>website</u>.
- Please keep in mind that we are a peanut free district as you send your child to school with the afternoon snack.













#### Items Children Will Need in School

- Backpack
- A water bottle labeled with the child's first and last name.
- 2 complete sets of clothing and 1 pair of shoes (comfortable and safe for your child to participate in daily gross motor activities) to be kept in school.
- Clothing should be put in a ziplock bag labeled with the child's first and last name.
- Each set should include:
  - o shirt
  - o pants
  - underwear
  - o socks





#### Items Children Will Need in School

Crib-size fitted sheet, small blanket, small pillow in a plastic bag.

- Please label the sheet, blanket and plastic bag.
- Please do **not** send in sleeping bags.
- These will be used during daily rest time.
- The sheet and blanket will be sent home every Friday for laundering at home.
- Please return a clean set the following Monday.
- You may want to purchase two sets to give yourself more time to





#### Items Children Will Not Need in School

We will supply all other items children will need.

- Notebooks please do not send in
- Pencils, Markers, Crayons please do not send in
- Toys please keep all toys at home or in the car for your child to play with on their way home.





#### Morning Drop-Off Procedures

- Each class will enter through a specific entrance.
- Doors will be open from 8:55 am to 9:04 am
- After 9:05 am only the Main Entrance will be open.



#### **Dismissal Procedures**

- Students must be picked up promptly at dismissal time:
  - o 11:30 am for AM session
  - o **3:00 pm** for PM and Full Day students
- Students will be dismissed at same door as arrival.
- Our district does not offer before or after-care supervision.
- However, students who attend Bright Adventures and Bright Seedlings
  have the option for paid morning and after-care. This is a separate
  service directly with the private providers. Please reach out to the
  private providers for additional information.



#### Important for Student Pick ups!

- Always update your contact information with us. That is how we communicate with you.
- Please fill out the **Authorization for Student Pick up** form that we will send you on the first day of school.
- Please ensure that anyone picking up your child that is not the parent or guardian has an ID.



#### **Monthly Drills**

If you need to come into the building for any reason, please call the school and make an appointment ahead of time.



#### Tips for the first day of school

- Your child may have separation anxiety on the first day of school. Please be assured that we will do everything to help your child transition into the school building.
- If your child has a difficult time on the first day of school, we will communicate with you during the day to update you on how she/he is doing.
- Consider packing a meal you know your child will eat on the first day of school in case they are not used to the school meals.
