## Senior Dues:

The cost of dues are \$165. Please note, there are a number of students who owe fines as a result of lost or damaged textbooks, calculators, or sports uniforms. We are unable to accept senior dues until these fines are paid and cleared. Students who do not pay senior dues will not receive their yearbook, cap or gown and will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony in June. Any student who wishes to set up a payment plan should see Mr. Brunacki (Room 348) or Ms. Kropilak (Room 187) BEFORE November 1<sup>st</sup>. Dues will not be accepted while class is in session. We will also have collection dates in room 212A on Friday, November 15, Friday, February 7 and Thursday, April 2 at 2:30pm.

## Senior Prom:

The senior prom is scheduled for Thursday, May 21, 2020, 7-11pm, at Westmount Country Club in Woodland Park (West Paterson). The charge is \$105 per person, and can only be paid *after* senior dues have been paid in full. Students and parents must sign a contract that is due at the time bids are paid. All guests will need to be approved by Mrs. Lozano, and no one over the age of 20 will be permitted to attend. Copies of this contract will be available beginning in March. More details regarding prom bids, contract and procedures will be sent out in March. Permission to attend the Prom is at the discretion of the Grade 12 Assistant Principal and HHS Administration. Senior prom collection will be held on April 15 and 16, 2020.

#### Fundraisers:

• Concession Stand- Each year, the senior class is responsible for running the concession stand during home football games. Parents and senior class members may work to offset the cost of senior dues and prom. Anyone interested in working any of the home football games should contact Mr. Brunacki or Ms. Kropilak immediately as spaces are limited. The dates of the games are:

- Wreaths- Traditionally, the senior class sells Wreaths during the holiday season. Seniors will receive the fundraising packet by the end of September. Any student who wishes to participate in the fundraiser will earn money to offset their senior dues and/or prom. Please keep in mind that there are minimum quantities required in order to fulfill any school order for wreaths. In the event that we do not meet this minimum, the fundraiser will be cancelled and all monies returned.
