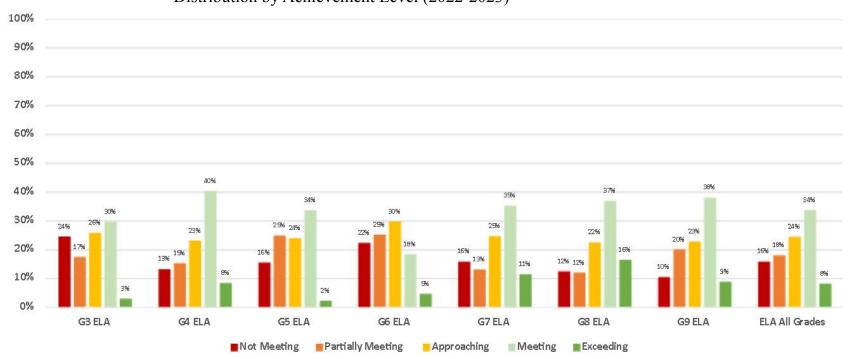

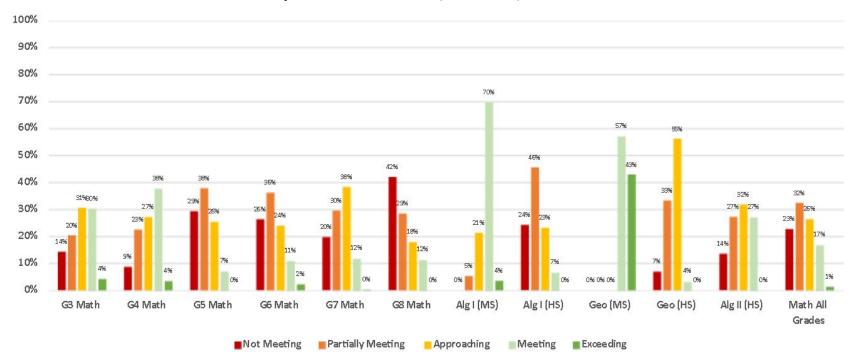

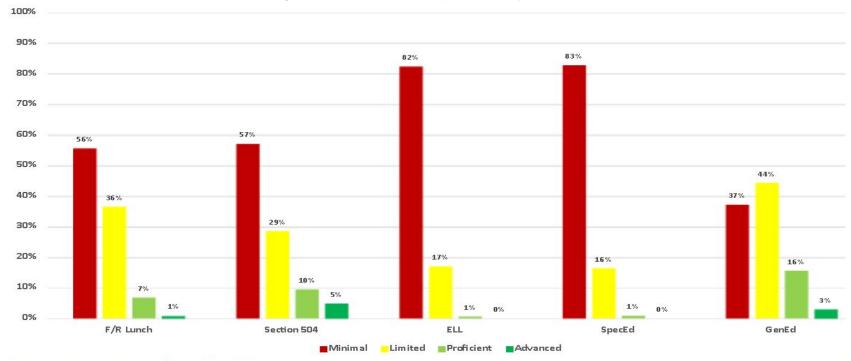
Hackensack Public Schools 2022-2023 Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Race Science







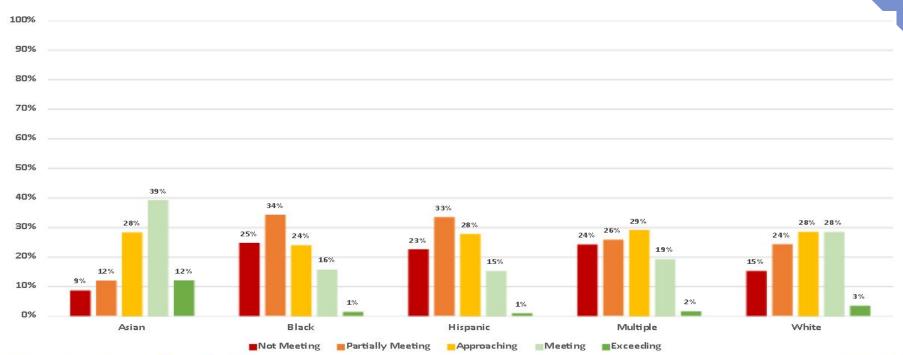
Hackensack Public Schools 2022-2023 Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Program Science







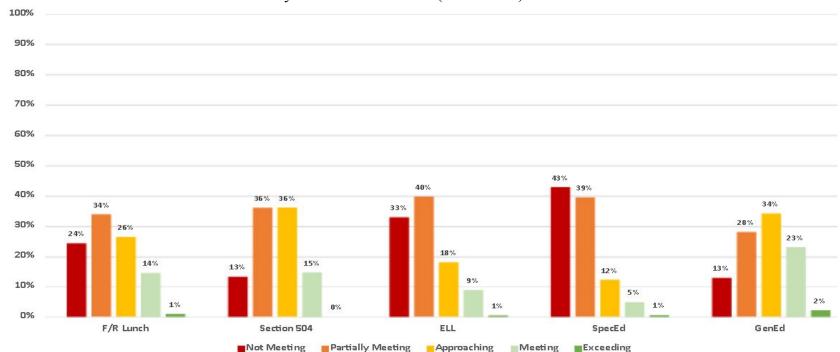
Hackensack Public Schools 2022-2023 Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Race Mathematics







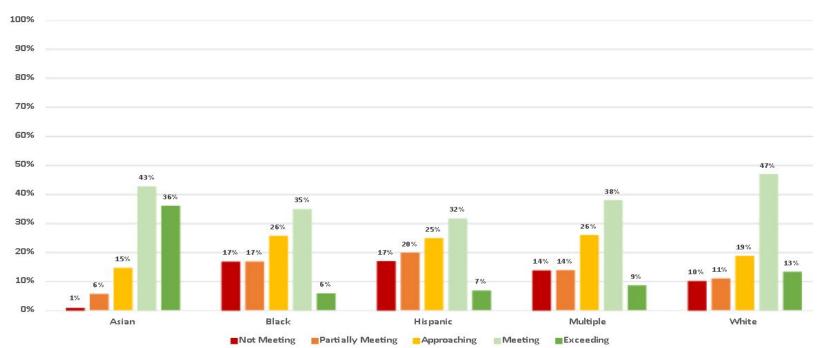

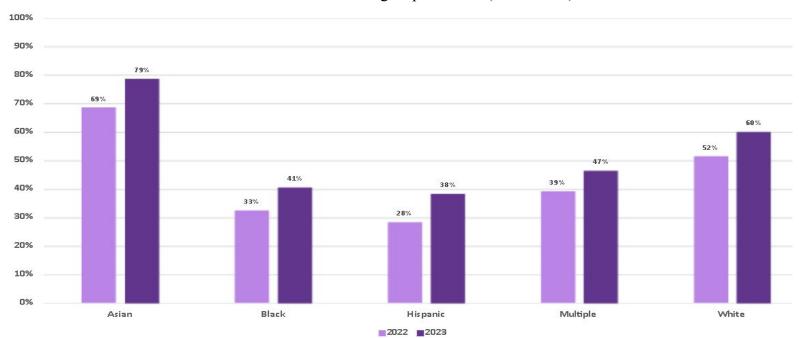

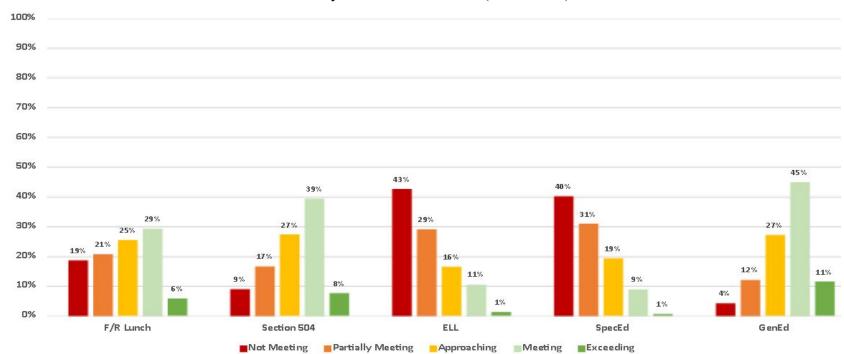
Year over Year % Meeting Expectations (All Grades)

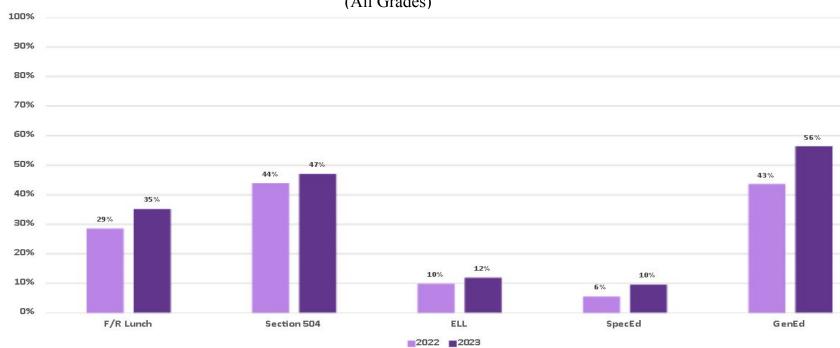
