Personal Information:

Students are to post their individual's personal information and interests using evidence from the text, class lessons, and the internet. Include a photograph of the individual.

Groups:

Students are to choose at least two groups (or clubs) that their individual may be a part of based on their interest.

Photo Albums:

Students are to think about places their individual may have taken pictures and/or people they may have taken pictures with. Photo albums must reflect key events or themes of the war.

(For example, Frederick Douglas may post a photo album of the 54th Massachusetts unit.)

Upcoming Events:

Students are to think about upcoming events that their individual may attend.

The Wall:

Students are to depict three other persons that might comment on their individual's profile page. The images and comments of the other persons should be appropriate to their individual as outlined in the text. (For example, Grant may write on Sherman's wall, "Way to light it up in Atlanta last night!")


