


# Scoring Rubric for Graphs

(Keep this in your binder to refer to all year.)

## 1. Labels

- a. X-axis labeled with independent variable (aka: manipulated or cause)
- b. Y-axis labeled with dependent variable (aka: responding or effect)
- c. Unit of measure identified on both axes, in parenthesis if warranted
- d. Title of graph given

## 2. Numbering

- a. Appropriate scale used
- b. Lines are numbered, not spaces
- c. Consistent intervals used  
(ex. 5, 10, 15, 20)
- d. Hatch marks used when necessary if skipping a chunk of numbers 

## 3. Reflects Data Accurately

- a. Coordinate points are plotted correctly
- b. Color coded, if necessary
- c. Create a key (legend) if needed in one of the corners

## 4. Easy to Read

- a. Neatly done with a ruler
- b. Neatly written letters and numbers
- c. Name, date, and period are on your work
