- a registered voter in the district
- not convicted of a disqualifying crime pursuant to N.J.S.A.18A:12-1

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Within 30 days of election or appointment to the board, a member must undergo a <u>criminal</u> <u>history background investigation</u> through the New Jersey Department of Education.
