- Read a fiction novel of your choosing (all genres of fiction are acceptable).
- Complete the graphic organizer found on the reverse side of your novel choice.
- Turn in the assignment when we return to school. Assignments will be due Tuesday, September 8th to be counted as the first grade of the marking period.

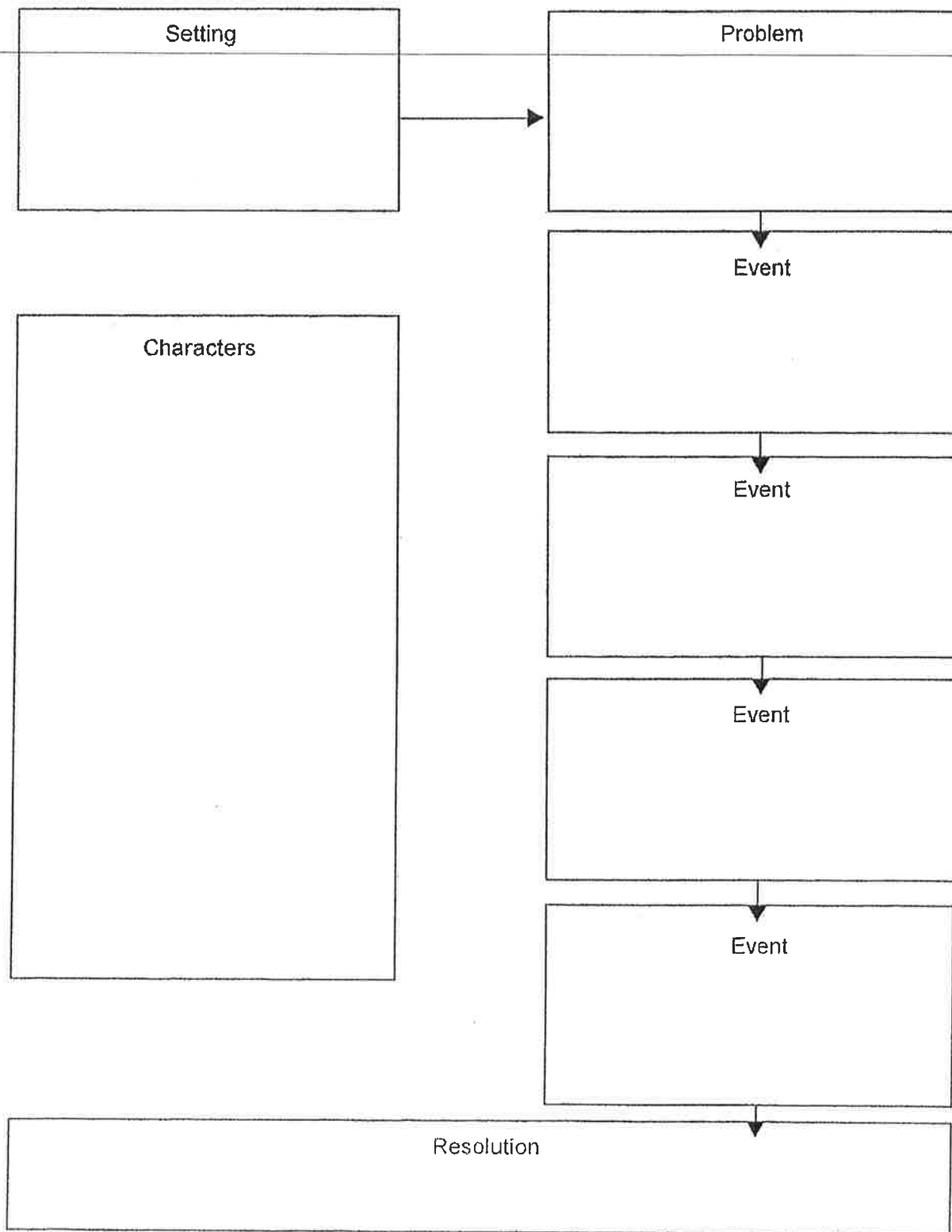
