

## GRADE 3 SUPPLY LIST

### Materials needed for continued Distance Learning

**OPTIONAL- We will be using Chromebooks daily, so these items would help your child work more proficiently.**

- Headphones with a microphone or earbuds
- Mouse (Wired or Wireless)
- 1 notebook
- Pencils
- A quiet place to work where your child can concentrate
- Optional: crayons, colored pencils, markers, construction paper

**Please send these items with your child on the first day we return to at-school learning. Label each item with your child's name.**

- 1-inch Binder
- 8 pack of dividers for Binder
- 5 marble composition notebooks - (red, blue, green, yellow, black)\*\*NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS
  - Spiral Notebooks for Moyano's Class ONLY
- 5 folders- red, blue, green, yellow, black
- 2 highlighters (any color)
- 1 black Sharpie marker (for labeling materials)
- 1 dry erase marker (any color)
- 1 box of colored pencils and/or 1 box of crayons
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 box of tissues for classroom use
- Hand Sanitizer
- 2 pens for correcting work (any color other than black)
- 2 boxes of **sharpened** Ticonderoga/Dixon pencils
- Erasers
- Plastic pencil BOX
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 ruler
- 2 packs of sticky note pads (like post-its) Approximately 3 in. x 3 in.

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### Some suggestions to start off the year at home:

\*\*\*Your cooperation is essential in developing a positive homework habit. First and foremost, you can encourage your child by showing interest and demonstrating helpful attitudes toward homework.

- Provide a noise-free, well-lit place to work.
- Have pencils and other necessary materials available for your child.
- Establish a regular "homework time" in the home and have a special place free from excessive noise.
- Help your child organize adequate time to complete activities neatly and carefully.
- Encourage your child to ask for help when he/she doesn't understand something or is frustrated. Teachers, like parents, can help only if they know there is a need.
- Decide if a task becomes too frustrating - stop and take a break. Any work done under duress or frustration is not a positive or healthy learning experience.

- Please maintain an open line of communication with your child's teacher. We are a team!
- Please check your child's book bag DAILY. Book bags should be cleaned out weekly.
