Criteria for Scholarship

- Applicant must be a member of the current graduating class of Hackensack High School. Applicant must have all passing grades by the midyear of their graduating year.
- Applicant must have a total cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.50
- Applicant must have been a part of the theatre arts program (on stage, backstage, in the music pit, or technical crew) at Hackensack High School for at least two years. High consideration in application scoring will be given to applicants with more than two years of participation in the theatre arts program and for those who served in an officer position in the Hackensack High School Drama Club.
- Applicant must be attending college for the performing arts (ie: theatre, musical theatre, dance, music, or stage management).
- Applicant must complete this application in its entirety. All requested information must be included with application.
- Financial need will be considered.

Completed applications with all requested materials must be given to the HHS Drama Club Advisor no later than April 30.
