COURSE DESCRIPTION

Learn vocal techniques, musical notation and terminology, rhythms, diction, sight-singing, and musical styles as applicable to musical theater. Emphasis is placed on musicality and musicianship relating to *ensemble performance*. Participation in all rehearsals and performances is required. Learn the history of musicals, exploring a variety of writers, styles, and time periods. All musical theater students are strongly encouraged to participate in the HHS Chorus.

CLASS RULES

1. Be respectful

- Be respectful towards your fellow students and the teacher
- Be open-minded about the various kinds of music we will be studying and respect the likes and dislikes of others
- Be respectful towards the classroom and the property of others

2. Be prepared

- Be on time (in your seat by the bell) with your folder, doing the DO NOW
- Participate fully in rehearsals try your best every day.

Let me know before class if you are sick and cannot participate fully on a given day

- Remain seated until you are dismissed from rehearsal

3. Be responsible

- practice your music/monologue and research your shows at home
- turn in all assignments on time
- follow all school rules (ex. no cell phones, no food in class, etc.)

Failure to adhere to classroom and school policies will result in student-teacher discussions, teacher-assigned detentions, parent phone calls and/or conferences, discipline referrals and other appropriate consequences.

MATERIALS

Bring a folder and a pencil to class. Make sure your name is on the front of the folder. Students may be loaned music, which must be returned in good condition. Students will be fined for damage occurring to loaned music or loss of music.

PERFORMANCE ATTIRE for Spring Showcase:

all black clothes: black pants and black top. Black shoes. Costume pieces as needed, to be determined.

CLASS PROCEDURES:

- 1. Sit in your assigned seat, which may be changed at any time by the teacher.
- 2. Place your belongings (purse, bag, books for other classes, etc.) on the shelves.

- 3. Avoid moving around the room during class whenever possible.
- 4. Always ask permission if you must leave the room. Sign the log and take the key. Only one person may be out at a time. Return as quickly as possible. Abuse of this privilege will result in consequences (call home, etc.)
- 5. Remain quiet while others are rehearsing and while the director is speaking. Raise your hand and wait to be called on if you have a question.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Attendance in this class is necessary and required to receive credit in the course. Course credit may be withdrawn if a student's total number of absences (excused and unexcused) is excessive: please see the student handbook for school-wide attendance policies. Attendance at the spring showcase performance is mandatory.

* If you are late to class without a pass, you are required to sign the Tardy Log near the door and report for teacher detention at 2:30 that day. * **GRADING** - please check Genesis regularly to see your grades and check for missing assignments.

- Participation in performances (in-class or outside of class) is a major part of the grade for this course. The dates of performances will be announced as far in advance as possible. The Spring Showcase will be on MAY 14 at 7:00 pm. It is the culminating assessment/performance for this course and participation is REQUIRED. Students are also required to attend the entire dress rehearsal during the school day on May 14th. Work release students must arrange to be present until 2:30.
- All musical theater students are REQUIRED to attend the Fall Play, The Crucible (Oct. 18-19 at HACPAC) AND the Spring Musical, The Wizard of Oz (March 26-29, HHS Aud.). Tickets cost approximately \$10-15. If this presents a financial hardship, please have a parent/caregiver contact me as early in the year as possible as there are a limited number of "scholarship" tickets available. Attendance at these performances will be part of the marking period grade.
- Students may be guizzed periodically on their ability to sing their vocal parts in music the group has learned. -Students will have access to a study guide for tests. There will be a mid-term and a final exam, in addition to any unit exams given. Graded classwork and homework may also be assigned.
- Students will sing in ensembles (and possibly solo) regularly during class; these performances will be graded.
- -There may be periodic graded "folder checks" to ensure students have all materials and are properly marking their music.

The musical theater classes start the year by singing songs from the Broadway musical *RENT*. In order for the students to understand the show in its entirety, we will be watching the feature film made in 2005. However, this movie version of the show has many alterations from the stage show. I will also show the 2008 *RENT: Filmed Live on Broadway*. This is a recording of the actual Broadway show. Because this version is NR (Not Rated) and because the musical deals with adult themes (the 2005 film was rated PG-13 for mature thematic material involving drugs and sexuality, and for some strong language), students will be required to have parental permission to view the film.

Rent is a rock musical with music and lyrics by Jonathan Larson loosely based on Puccini's opera La Bohème. It tells the story of a group of impoverished young artists struggling to survive and create a life in New York City's East Village in the thriving days of Bohemian Alphabet City, under the shadow of HIV/AIDS. The musical was first seen Off-Broadway in 1994. The show won a Pulitzer Prize, and the production was a hit. The musical moved to Broadway in 1996 and closed in 2008.
